- Whooo’s That Flying? – Learn about owls and their role in the environment.
- Predator and Prey ** – Learn about the food chain. Live animal visitor.
- Oregon Trail – Learn about travel along the Oregon Trail in a covered wagon.
- River Mammals – Learn about river otters and beavers.
- All about Amphibians ** – Learn about toads and frogs. Live animal visitor.
- Eruption! – An introduction of volcanoes for young students.
- Learning about Lizards ** – Learn about lizards. Live animal visitor.
- Native American Myths & Art ** – Connect modern day to the origin roots of North America/Oregon. Live animal visitor.
