Responsibilities and Tasks

- 3. Prepare and cook food based on menu selection and daily specials
- 4. Receive and check in product as necessary
- 5. Follow proper food handling procedures, possess basic knowledge in the use and maintenance of various kitchen operations including but not limited to: grill, oven, microwave, etc.
- 6. Comply with all Museum policies, procedures and safety regulations including strict adherence to all Health & Safety Standards
- 7. Take visitors' food orders using the highest quality customer service including cross promotion of museum events and programs

- 8. Relay visitor comments, suggestions and requests to appropriate staff. Answer general museum questions as able, relaying others to appropriate staff or volunteers
- 9. Assist with bussing the tables, dishwashing and keeping the café clean and stocked
- 10. Properly store food at the end of the day in designated containers and storage areas to prevent spoilage, portion and wrap the food, or place it directly on plates for service to patrons
- 11. Support closing duties, including storing all reusable goods, breaking down goods, cleaning all equipment and areas, returning equipment to proper locations, restocking items, turning off lights, locking doors, and completing daily cleaning checklist
- 12. Waive meal period where you will not be relieved of all duty. However, you will be provided a reasonable opportunity to consume food during any work shift of six hours or longer while continuing to work during which you will be paid for this time.
- 13. Perform other tasks and duties as assigned
