Job Summary – Head Chef

The Head Chef is responsible for being a culinary leader for the Museum. The Head Chef will assist the Café Manager in guiding the café team to deliver a museum-inspired menu in our casual dining setting. Is also responsible for supervising and providing feedback to the cafe staff. This position reports to the Café Manager and serves as backup in manager's absence, fulfilling all the manager's duties, including the planning and execution of events.

Responsibilities and Tasks

Menu Development

- 1. Develop and plan seasonal menus, daily specials, and banquet/catering offerings.
- 2. Manage food costing and inventory.

Kitchen Management

- 3. Create prep lists for café staff.
- 4. Maintain standards for food storage, rotation, quality, and appearance.
- 5. Establish maintenance and cleaning schedules for equipment, storage, and work areas.

6. Ensure compliance with applicable health codes and regulations.

Café Leadership

- 7. Assist Café Manager in leading, mentoring, and managing the café team, with a focus on developing the team's culinary skills.
- 8. Participate in the interview process and selection of cafe staff.
- 9. Establish production and staff schedules to ensure timely delivery of food service.
- 10. Obtain feedback on food and service quality, and handle customer problems and complaints.
- 11. Participate in the development of and adherence to budgetary objectives for the café.
- 12. Meet with customers as needed to arrange menu items and negotiate prices for catered weddings, banquets, and other special events.
- 13. Assists café team in order taking, cashiering, food running, table maintenance, and order preparation.
- 14. Other duties as assigned.
