#### **VOLUNTEER JOB SUMMARY**

Behind the Scenes (BTS) Wildlife volunteers assist Wildlife keepers with animal care and husbandry in specific areas including Desertarium and Birds of Prey. Typical tasks include cleaning of enclosures, removal of fecal material, washing, disinfecting surfaces, and changing water. Volunteers help keep work areas clean and organized by doing laundry, washing dishes, sweeping, and mopping. Diet preparation including the processing of whole-animal foods for carnivore species is required. BTS volunteers may also be invited to assist keepers with animal training sessions, enrichment opportunities, minor veterinary procedures, or help with other special projects as necessary.
